Campership

We offer two levels of campership, full or half. Please mark one box to indicate your choice.

Half – I can afford some of the camp fees.

A half-campership is worth 50% of the lowest registration tier. Complete this form and submit it to apply.*

Full – I cannot afford to pay anything for my summer camp fees.

This level of campership requires additional verification*. Full Campership applicants must also supply one of the following with their application for it to be complete:

A) A letter of recommendation establishing financial need from a religious leader, member of your congregation's ruling council, teacher, principal, social worker, youth worker, or another person with standing in your community. It should not be someone who is only a family member or friend.

OR

B) The first two pages of your Form 1040 for the most recent tax year showing that your income is less than 200% of the federal poverty level for your household size.

OR

C) The current determination letter for a means-tested public benefit (like food stamps) that you or someone in your household receives.

*Camp Westminster reserves the ability to request further information from families to determine campership eligibility.
